Their responsibilities have been extended to include Ukrainian refugees.



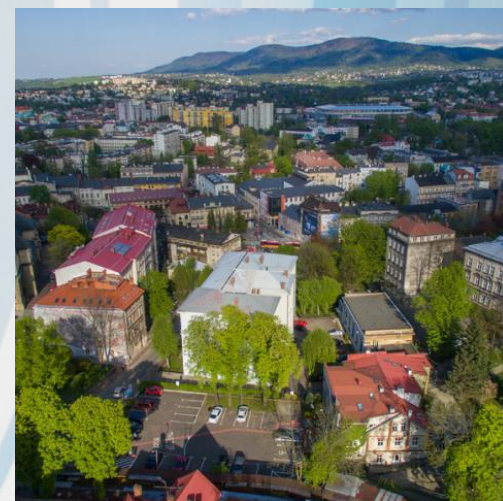
